POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (March 5, 2019) Two super load moves, involving the hauling of two mobile homes, could cause delays in traffic on Thursday, March 7, 2019 at 9 a.m.

The moves will begin in North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on the Franklin Bypass to eastbound Route 58 to South Quay Road and will end in the 8100 block of South Quay Road.

The trucks and loads will measure 15 feet 10 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 64 feet long, and weigh 80,000 pounds.

The moves will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police Department escorts.
