POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – SUPER LOAD MOVES MONDAY EVENING

SUFFOLK, VA (April 12, 2019) Two super load moves involving the hauling of wall support systems could cause delays in traffic Monday evening, April 15th, between 9:30 p.m. and 10:30 p.m.

The moves will begin in Portsmouth and ultimately end in North Carolina and will travel through Suffolk on US 58 westbound to Route 13/58/460 via the Suffolk Bypass, to US58 west via the Holland Bypass, and to US 58 west via the Franklin Bypass.

The truck and loads will measure 13'6" tall, 21'8" wide, 75 feet long, and weigh 80,000 pounds.

The moves will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police Department escorts and State Police escorts. Minor traffic delays should be expected due to the width of the loads.
