POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS – SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (April 30, 2019) Two super load moves, each involving the hauling of a modular home, could cause delays in traffic on Wednesday, May 1, 2019 between 11 a.m. and 1 p.m.

The moves will begin in North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on the Franklin Bypass to eastbound Route 58 to South Quay Road to Route 58 Business/South Quay Road to Holland Road to East Glen Haven Drive to Kingsale Road and will end the trips in the 200 block of Kingsale Road.

Each truck and load will measure 14 feet 10 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 100 feet long, and weigh 80,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police Department escorts.
