TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT INVOLVING DUMP TRUCK BRIDGE ROAD

SUFFOLK, VA (May 21, 2019) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of an accident involving a passenger vehicle and dump truck earlier this morning, Tuesday, May 21, 2019.

Emergency Communications received the call at 11:51 a.m. advising of the accident involving a Ford Dump Truck and a Kia Soul at the intersection of Bridge Road and Windward Lane.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and two adults and two juveniles in the Kia Soul were ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital and CHKD for further treatment of non-life threatening injuries. An adult male in the dump truck was ground transported to a local hospital after Chesapeake Fire & Rescue provided mutual aid during the accident response.

All southbound lanes on Bridge Road were initially closed in the immediate area following the accident, with one lane reopening and then all lanes reopened to through traffic at 1:08 p.m.

The investigation into the cause of the accident remains ongoing at this time.
