FAWN RESCUED FROM STORM DRAIN

SUFFOLK, VA (June 12, 2019) Suffolk Animal Control was assisted by Suffolk Fire & Rescue's Technical Rescue Team to rescue a young fawn trapped in a storm drain earlier this morning.

Emergency Communications initially received the call from a citizen regarding the fawn trapped in a storm drain in the 1100 block of White Herons Lane in the Herons Pointe neighborhood.

Members of the Technical Rescue Team were able to extricate the fawn without incident at approximately 11:15 a.m. and it was turned over to Animal Control Officers on scene for further evaluation.

Suffolk Animal Control will be coordinating with Wildlife Response, Inc. to set-up transport so that the young fawn can be rehabilitated.
