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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 2, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, July 2, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Route 10 and Wilroy Road for vegetation maintenance from 4 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 3900 block of Sleepy Hole Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the sidewalk closed in the 100 block of North Main Street for repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Desert Road, Longstreet Lane, Elwood Road, Jenkins Mill, and Barnes Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have crews working in the 6600 block of Crittenden Road between Sandy Bottom and Route 17 and Kings Highway at Godwin Boulevard, Shell Road and Cedar Crest Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Hillpoint Boulevard between Birdie Driver and Niblick Circle for tree removals from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 2 and July 3.

(Vernon Drive) – A contractor will have Vernon Drive closed at Magnolia Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Mineral Spring Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and Robertson Street for concrete work from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway spraying the medians from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Old Mill Creek Neighborhood) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the Old Mill Creek Neighborhood spraying and cutting vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Garfield Avenue, Alabama Avenue, Georgia Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Garfield Avenue, Alabama Avenue, and Georgia Avenue for slope mowing from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a northbound mobile operation on Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 460) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 460 between Route 58 interchange and Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Mill Wood Way) – A contractor will have a crew working in the 1700 block of Mill Wood Way, Tuesday, July 9, from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 10 through July 12.

Ongoing Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a periodic southbound flagging operations within the 900 to 1600 blocks of Carolina Road and the 1500 to 1800 blocks of Whaleyville Boulevard for shoulder restoration and final pavement repairs from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 20 through July 31.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete in August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months. Variable message boards were placed May 28 to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

(Magnolia Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage upgrades on Magnolia Drive between Brookwood Drive and Camellia Avenue. Full replacement of the curb and gutter will take place during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning June 3, 2019 with an expected completion date of July 19, 2019. During this time, street parking within the work area will not be permitted and access to driveways may be impacted for a short duration. Residents received notice of the upcoming work on May 24, 2019.

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
