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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 3, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, July 3, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Hillpoint Boulevard between Birdie Drive and Niblick Circle for tree removal from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Harborwood Place) – A contractor will have a crew in the 8000 block of Harborwood Place from 12 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard for vegetation maintenance in the medians from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Route 13/32) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for pothole patching from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 600 block of Manning Road and 1200 block of Cherry Grove Road for pothole patching from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and the Chesapeake City line for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Elwood Road, Harvest Drive, Glen Haven Drive, Barnes Road and Brentwood Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Mill Wood Way) – A contractor will have a crew working in the 1700 block of Mill Wood Way, Tuesday, July 9, from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 10 through July 12.

Ongoing Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a periodic southbound flagging operation within the 900 to 1600 blocks of Carolina Road and the 1500 to 1800 blocks of Whaleyville Boulevard for shoulder restoration and final pavement repairs from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 20 through July 31.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete in August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months. Variable message boards were placed May 28 to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

(Magnolia Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage upgrades on Magnolia Drive between Brookwood Drive and Camellia Avenue. Full replacement of the curb and gutter will take place during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning June 3, 2019 with an expected completion date of July 19, 2019. During this time, street parking within the work area will not be permitted and access to driveways may be impacted for a short duration. Residents received notice of the upcoming work on May 24, 2019.

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
