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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 12, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, July 12, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Mill Wood Way) – A contractor will have a crew working in the 1700 block of Mill Wood Way, Wednesday through Friday, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 10 through July 12.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound inside lane closure on Bridge Road at Windward Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., July 9 through July 17.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Kings Highway and Portsmouth Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation West Constance Road between Western Avenue and the 600 block from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 12 and July 15.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Shoulders Hill Road, Pughsville Road, Wedgewood Road, Lucy Cross Road, and Mineral Spring Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Roundtable Court) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Roundtable Court for paving from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Sleepy Lake Parkway and Bayberry Lane) – A contractor will have crews in the 1500 block of Sleepy Lake Parkway and the 1500 Bayberry Lane from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound and westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Chesapeake City line and Pitchkettle Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound and westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Pitchkettle Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m., July 13.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have alternating lane closures on eastbound Route 58 between Dutch Road and Pioneer Road to repair a washout from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and the North Carolina State line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 13.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 400 and 1500 blocks of East Glenhaven Drive, 7000 block of Elwood Road and 6800 block of Brentwood Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for shoulder maintenance.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 7100 block of Elwood Road, Ruritan Boulevard, Buckhorn Drive at Indian Trail and the 9000 block of South Quay Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Wilroy Road) – Beginning Sunday, July 14, a contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Wilroy Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 2300 block overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The paving operation is expected to be complete Friday, July 19.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have the southbound turn lane closed in the 1100 block of Carolina Road for pavement repair from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., July 15.

Ongoing Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a periodic southbound flagging operations within the 900 to 1600 blocks of Carolina Road and the 1500 to 1800 blocks of Whaleyville Boulevard for shoulder restoration and final pavement repairs from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 20 through July 31.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months. Variable message boards were placed May 28 to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

(Magnolia Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage upgrades on Magnolia Drive between Brookwood Drive and Camellia Avenue. Full replacement of the curb and gutter will take place during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning June 3, 2019 with an expected completion date of July 19, 2019. During this time, street parking within the work area will not be permitted and access to driveways may be impacted for a short duration. Residents received notice of the upcoming work on May 24, 2019.

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
