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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 19, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, July 19, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Lloyd Street closed with a detour from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., July 19 and July 20.

(Old Myrtle Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 5000 block Old Myrtle Road from 10 am. to 12 pm. for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(White Dogwood Trail and Crooked Creek Farm Road) – A contractor will have crews working in the 1500 block of White Dogwood Trail and Crooked Creed Farm Road (private) from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have alternating northbound and southbound shoulder closures on College Drive at Route 664 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, July 19 and a southbound shoulder closure from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday, July 20.

(North Commerce Street) – A contractor will have a sidewalk closure in the 100 block of North Commerce Street, July 19 through August 10.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Holland Road between the bridge and the Route 13/32 Bypass for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Kenyon Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., July 19 and July 20.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation southbound and returning northbound on Whaleyville Boulevard between downtown Whaleyville and the North Carolina state line for vegetation maintenance from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive and Girl Scout Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Lake Prince Drive and Girl Scout Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Ellis Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Ellis Road for slope mowing from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Manning Bridge Road and Freeman Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Manning Bridge Road and Freeman Mill Road for vegetation maintenance on the bridges from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 9000 block of Eclipse Drive for a paving operation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 24 and July 25.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., July 20.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive.

Ongoing Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a periodic southbound flagging operations within the 900 to 1600 blocks of Carolina Road and the 1500 to 1800 blocks of Whaleyville Boulevard for shoulder restoration and final pavement repairs from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 20 through July 31.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months. Variable message boards were placed May 28 to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

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
