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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 22, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, July 22, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Lloyd Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road to downtown Holland for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation southbound and returning northbound on Whaleyville Boulevard between downtown Whaleyville and the North Carolina state line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive and Girl Scout Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Lake Prince Drive and Girl Scout Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Eclipse Drive and Crooked Creek Farm Road) – A contractor will have crews on Eclipse Drive and Crooked Creek Farm Road (private) from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Respass Beach Road) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure in the 6700 block of Respass Beach Road from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a southbound flagging operation in the 1300 to 1400 block of Carolina Road for pavement repair and evaluation from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Ruritan Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Ruritan Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 4 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bennetts Creek Landing) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the Bennetts Creek Landing Neighborhood for tree trimming from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Joshua Lane, Exeter Drive and Gardner Lane for vegetation maintenance on the bridges from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operation on Horton Drive, Airport Road, Mockingbird Lane, Matoaka Road and Girl Scout Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Old South Quay Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 7100 block of Old South Quay Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Grove Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Grove Avenue for ditch maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Barnes Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Barnes Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lummis Road and Herman Court) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 200 block of Lummis Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and Herman Court from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. for drainage maintenance.

Upcoming Projects:

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 9000 block of Eclipse Drive for a paving operation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 24 and July 25.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

Ongoing Projects:

(North Commerce Street) – A contractor will have a sidewalk closure in the 100 block of North Commerce Street, July 19 through August 10.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months.

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
