**SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE –  
SLEEPY LAKE PARKWAY**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 22, 2019) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a residential structure fire early this morning, Monday, July 22, 2019, in the 1500 block of Sleepy Lake Parkway. Emergency Communications was contacted at 3:38 a.m.

Captain Nick Savage advised that the first units arrived on the scene at 3:49 a.m. and found heavy fire showing through the roof. Crews moved into defensive operations and were able avoid any spreading to other structures. The fire was marked under control at 4:51 a.m. No one was home at the time of the fire. No injuries were reported.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Battalion 2, Battalion 3, Engine 2, Engine 25, Engine 5, Engine 9, EMS 1, Ladder 5, Medic 5A, Rescue 1, Safety 1, and Rehab 6.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
