(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating northbound lane closures on Bridge Road at the Godwin Bridge for pavement repair overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 24, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, July 24, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between downtown Holland and Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between downtown Whaleyville and Carolina Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Ruritan Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Ruritan Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 6900 block of Corinth Chapel Road for an emergency tree removal from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Labrador Lane, West Liberty Spring Road and in the 4000 block of Edinburgh Court for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 500 block of Turlington Road, 1700 block of Longstreet lane, Greenway Road, Greenwood Road, 6000 block of Old Myrtle Road, Desert Road and the 7000 block of Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 9000 block of Eclipse Drive for a paving operation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 24 and July 25.

Upcoming Projects:

(Exeter Drive) – A contractor will have Exeter Drive closed with a detour between Lake Prince Drive and Gardner Lane for bridge repair, July 29 through August 2. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

Ongoing Projects:

(North Commerce Street) – A contractor will have a sidewalk closure in the 100 block of North Commerce Street, July 19 through August 10.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 7.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
