SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT – JOSHUA LANE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 29, 2019) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a single vehicle accident in the 2100 block of Joshua Lane last night, Sunday, July 28, 2019. Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at 8:25 p.m.

A vehicle reportedly left the roadway and struck a power pole and several trees. The only occupant of the vehicle had to be extricated from the vehicle. Following assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel, the adult male was airlifted to an area hospital by Nightingale with life threatening injuries. The roadway at that location was closed until about 4 a.m. this morning, Monday, July 29, 2019, due to the repair work by Dominion Power to the power pole.

The accident remains under investigation.
