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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 31, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, July 31, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between Kings Highway to the Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on Freeney Avenue at South Division Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between South Quay Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure on North Main Street at Western Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway in Chuckatuck for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Lee Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 200 block of Lee Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Suburban Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Suburban Drive between Redgate Drive and Woods Parkway from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Prince Drive at the bridge for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Shelito Lane and Jackson Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Shelito Lane and Jackson Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Lake Prince Drive at Exeter Drive for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Manning Road, Cypress Chapel Road, and Greenway Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(North Commerce Street) – A contractor will have a sidewalk closure in the 100 block of North Commerce Street, July 19 through August 10.

(Exeter Drive) – A contractor will have Exeter Drive closed with a detour between Lake Prince Drive and Gardner Lane for bridge repair, July 29 through August 2. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open Friday, August 2. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have a crew working on Foxcroft Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 7.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
