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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 7, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, August 7, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on Freeney Avenue from South Lloyd Street to the dead end from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Suburban Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Suburban Drive between Red Gate Drive and Woods Parkway from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 6 through August 9.

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Eclipse Drive at Steeple Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 6 through August 9.

(Holy Neck Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 7000 block of Holy Neck Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Fort Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be replacing wooden curbing with concrete curbing on Fort Street between Dumville Avenue and East Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 8 through September 15.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound and westbound mobile operations on Route 58 between Wilroy Road and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road from College Drive to Isle of Wight County for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the Chesapeake City line and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Brewers Creek Lane and Lakeview Court) – A contractor will have crews working on Brewers Creek Lane and Lakeview Court from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on East Washington Street at Commerce Street overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., August 7 and August 8.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Carolina Road between Copeland Road and Cypress Chapel Road from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Lee Farm Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lee Farm Lane for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 1400 block of Wilroy Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a crew working on Nansemond Parkway at the Route 58 overpass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Dill Road, Holy Neck Road, and Greenwood Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Southwestern Boulevard, Vicksburg Road, Mineral Spring Road, Arthur Drive, Pittmantown Road, and Freeman Mill Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **Upcoming Projects:**

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

### **Ongoing Projects:**

(North Commerce Street) – A contractor will have a sidewalk closure in the 100 block of North Commerce Street, July 19 through August 10.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open August 16. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Exeter Drive) – A contractor will have Exeter Drive closed with a detour between Lake Prince Drive and Gardner Lane for bridge repair, July 29 through August 9. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have a crew working on Foxcroft Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 30.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
