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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 13, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, August 13, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Kings Highway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Kings Highway between Bennetts Pasture Road and Sleepy Hole Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 Interchange and the Reid's Ferry Bridge for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard from Wilroy Road to Route 58 for vegetation maintenance and litter control from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a southbound mobile operation on Carolina Road between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the North Carolina State line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road at the Mills Godwin Bridge for an inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 4300 block of Lake Prince Drive from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Milners Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 block of Milners Road from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure in the 800 block of Wilroy Road from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 13 and August 14.

(Haskins Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a crew working on Haskins Drive for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Falcon Street and Beamons Mill Trail for slope mowing from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Turlington Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a crew working in the 500 block of Turlington Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Quince Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Quince Road between Longstreet Lane and Hare Road for asphalt and ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Gates Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Gates Road and Camp Pond Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Everets Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Everets Road for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a right shoulder closure on Route 58 at the Route 13/32 Bypass for an inspection on the bridge over the train tracks from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 14.

(Centerbrooke Lane) – A contractor will have a lane shift on Centerbrooke Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 14.

Ongoing Projects:

(North Main Street and Constance Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures northbound and southbound on North Main Street between Constance Road and the entrance to Lowe's, Constance Road between North Main Street and Church Street, and Constance Road between North Main Street and the entrance to the Hilton Garden Inn Suffolk Riverfront for milling and paving overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, August 11. The paving operation will take place nightly, Sunday through Saturday, is expected to be complete by August 25.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 9 through August 30.

(Fort Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be replacing wooden curbing with concrete curbing on Fort Street between Dumville Avenue and East Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 7 through September 15.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open August 16. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have a crew working on Foxcroft Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 30.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 15, 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
