ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 19, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, August 19, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between the North Carolina state line and Carolina Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Eclipse Drive between Steeple Drive and White Dogwood Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pembroke Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pembroke Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the 164 Interchange for vegetation maintenance from 11:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Manning Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Holland Road between West Washington Street and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a left shoulder closure on eastbound Route 58 at the crossover at the weigh scales for guardrail repairs from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 5100 block of Godwin Boulevard for guardrail repairs from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Bridge Road between Governor's Pointe Drive and Bennetts Creek Landing from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in both directions on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Elwood Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Elwood Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue at South Division Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pruden Boulevard for asphalt maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Deerfield Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be in the Deerfield Subdivision cleaning storm drains from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Ashburn Road and Deer Path Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Ashburn Road and Deer Path Road for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on South Main Street, Western Avenue, Pine Street, and Hodges Drive for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

Ongoing Projects:

(North Main Street and Constance Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures northbound and southbound on North Main Street between Constance Road and the entrance to Lowe's, Constance Road between North Main Street and Church Street, and Constance Road between North Main Street and the entrance to the Hilton Garden Inn Suffolk Riverfront for milling and paving overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, August 11. The paving operation will take place nightly, Sunday through Saturday, is expected to be complete August 25.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 9 through August 30.

(Fort Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be replacing wooden curbing with concrete curbing on Fort Street between Dumville Avenue and East Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 7 through September 15.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open Friday, August 23. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have a crew working on Foxcroft Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 30.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete September 5, 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.
