### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 21, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, August 21, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Eclipse Drive between Steeple Drive and White Dogwood Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 20 through August 23.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations east and westbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Downtown Holland for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue closed between South Lloyd Street and the dead end from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bayberry Cove Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be in the Bayberry Cove Subdivision cleaning storm drains from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 1500 block of Nansemond Parkway for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the Chesapeake City line and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard between Pembroke Lane and Moores Farm Lane from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard and Harbour Towne Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering will have a crew working at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and Harbour Towne Parkway from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. Suffolk Police will be directing traffic during this time.

(Kings Fork Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Kings Fork Road between the 2200 block and Lake Meade for a milling operation at the bridge from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the Whaleyville area for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pineview Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Pineview Road closed between Corinth Chapel Road and Gates Road for drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road and Indian Trail) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Lake Kilby Road and Indian Trail for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Drum Hill Road, Longstreet Lane, Barnes Road, and Harvest Drive for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday, August 24.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Avenue and Brookwood Drive. The start date is to be announced.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(North Main Street and Constance Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures northbound and southbound on North Main Street between Constance Road and the entrance to Lowe's, Constance Road between North Main Street and Church Street, and Constance Road between North Main Street and the entrance to the Hilton Garden Inn Suffolk Riverfront for milling and paving overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, August 11. The paving operation will take place nightly, Sunday through Saturday, is expected to be complete August 25.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 9 through August 30.

(Fort Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be replacing wooden curbing with concrete curbing on Fort Street between Dumville Avenue and East Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 7 through September 15.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open Friday, August 30. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have a crew working on Foxcroft Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by August 30.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete September 5, 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
