ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 27, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, August 27, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 189) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 189 for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on South Quay Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue between South Division Street and South Lloyd Street closed from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street and White Marsh Road from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Southampton County line for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 Interchange and the Reids Ferry Bridge for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard between Wilroy Road and Route 58 for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will have a paving operation on Magnolia Drive between Camellia Drive and College Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure in the 400 block of North Main Street from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile shoulder closure westbound on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road and the 3200 block of from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(White Marsh Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on White Marsh Road between Locust Street and Truman Road for CCTV evaluations from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pittmantown Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pittmantown Road for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations throughout the Whaleyville area for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Kennedy Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the Lake Kennedy Subdivision on vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Indian Trail, Buckhorn Drive, Chappell Drive, Airport Road, Turlington Road and Manning Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have Nansemond Parkway closed with a detour between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 28.

Ongoing Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 9 through August 30.

(Fort Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be replacing wooden curbing with concrete curbing on Fort Street between Dumville Avenue and East Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 7 through September 15.

(Corinth Chapel Road) – Beginning, Monday, July 29, a contractor will have Corinth Chapel Road closed with a detour between Camp Pond Road and Gates Road for milling and paving. The road will remain closed to through traffic this week and is expected to open Friday, August 30. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete September 5, 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
