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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 10, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, September 10, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1400 block of Carolina Road for an emergency water valve repair from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Burnetts Way) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on Burnetts Way at Jonathans Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North 4th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have the 300 block of North 4th Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lummis Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Lummis Road between Copeland Road and Porterfield lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Collins Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Collins Road for litter control from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on secondary roadways throughout the Whaleyville area for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Bennetts Creek Landing, Windy Point Drive, Lookout Circle and Club Road for milling and paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., September 10 through September 13.

(Peppercorn Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a crew in the 1400 block of Peppercorn Lane for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pineview Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Pineview Road at Gates Road for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Wilroy Road and the Chesapeake city line then return westbound to the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound and westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Chesapeake City line and the Route 13/32 Bypass for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 4100 to 4800 block of Manning Road for a milling and paving operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed with a detour at South Division Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Wedgewood Drive, Longstreet Lane, Indian Trail, Kings Highway and Godwin Boulevard between Kings Highway and Pembroke Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school busses only.

Ongoing Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Monticello View and Cedar Lake Drive for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., September 9 through September 13.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
