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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 19, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, September 19, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have alternating left turn lane closures at the intersection of Carolina Road and Obici Industrial Boulevard from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have alternating left turn closures at the intersection of North Main Street and Murphys Mill Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will be working in the 100 block of Foxcroft Road, September 19 and September 20.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Carolina Road and downtown Whaleyville for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway between Godwin Boulevard and the dead end for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Lincoln Avenue) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 900 block of Lincoln Avenue for an emergency sewer main installation from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Harvest Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on the shoulder of Harvest Drive at the bridge for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Quince Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on the shoulder on Quince Road at the bridge for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Harbourview Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure in the 5800 block of Harbourview Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Suburban Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 200 to 300 blocks Suburban Drive for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the 5200 block and the Isle of Wight county line for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 400 block of Godwin Boulevard for a gas line repair from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., September 17 through September 24.

(Hosier Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Hosier Road in the 1800 to 1900 blocks for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Babtown Road) – A contractor will have Babtown Road between Carolina Road and Whaleyville Road closed with a detour, September 16 and September 24.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue closed with a detour between South Division Street and South Lloyd Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works crews will have mobile operations on Turlington Road, Hosier Road, Jasmine Lane, Tree Lane, and Cumberland Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have crews working on Route 58 at Manning Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., September 23.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have West Washington Street between Saratoga Street and North Main Street closed with a detour. The project will run from 10 p.m., Saturday, September 21 until 8 p.m., Sunday, September 22.

Ongoing Projects:

(Bridge Road) – Beginning Sunday, September 15, 2019, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road between the Chesapeake City line and Harbour View Boulevard overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for milling and paving for approximately 3 weeks.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school busses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
