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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 20, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, September 20, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will be working in the 100 block of Foxcroft Road.

(Lincoln Avenue) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 900 block of Lincoln Avenue for an emergency sewer main installation from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Harbourview Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure in the 5800 block of Harbourview Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Suburban Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 200 to 300 blocks Suburban Drive for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Finney Avenue and Moore Avenue) – A contractor will have alternating left turn lane closures at the intersection of Finney Avenue and Moore Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Hartford Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between downtown Whaleyville and the North Carolina state line for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right turn lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at Hillpoint Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(OKelly Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on the shoulder of OKelly Drive at the bridge for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 400 block of Godwin Boulevard for a gas line repair from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., September 17 through September 24.

(Babbtown Road) – A contractor will have Babbtown Road between Carolina Road and Whaleyville Road closed with a detour, September 16 and September 24.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue closed with a detour between South Division Street and South Lloyd Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works crews will have mobile operations on Southwestern Boulevard, Leafwood Road, and Greenwood Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have crews working on Shady Grove Lane, Governors Wharf, Spring Meadow Lane, 1400 block of Kings Highway, 1400 block of Bridge Point Trail, 6500 block of Ferry Road, Crooked Creek Farm Road, Waters End Farm Lane, and the 6900 block of Crittenden Road for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have crews working on Route 58 at Manning Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., September 23.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have West Washington Street between Saratoga Street and North Main Street closed with a detour. The project will run from 10 p.m., Saturday, September 21 until 8 p.m., Sunday, September 22.

Ongoing Projects:

(Bridge Road) – Beginning Sunday, September 15, 2019, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road between the Chesapeake City line and Harbour View Boulevard overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for milling and paving for approximately 3 weeks.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school busses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
