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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 25, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, September 25, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation southbound on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Lincoln Avenue) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 900 block of Lincoln Avenue for a sewer repair from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Main Street and Murphys Mill Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Main Street and Murphys Mill Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(Main Street) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Main Street at the Suffolk Plaza entrance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway from the Chesapeake City line to Shoulders Hill Road for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations in both directions on Route 58 between Old South Quay Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a left lane closure westbound on Route 58 at the Blackwater Bridge from 10:30 a.m. to approximately 2 p.m. and a right shoulder closure westbound on Route 58 at Route 460 from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. for guardrail repairs.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound mobile operation on Bridge Road between Tautog Road and Crittenden Road from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a left turn lane closure and a right lane closure on Bridge Road at Windward Lane overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(West Constance Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on West Constance Road between Broad Street and Pitchkettle Road from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Driver Lane and the 4500 block of drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for herbicide application from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between the 800 block and Whaleyville Boulevard for herbicide application from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations throughout the Whaleyville area for asphalt maintenance from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pineview Road and Gates Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation at the intersection of Pineview Road and Gates Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Delaware Avenue and Park Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working at the intersection of Delaware Avenue and Park Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Mayflower Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the 800 block of Mayflower Drive for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Babbtown Road) – A contractor will have Babbtown Road between Carolina Road and Whaleyville Road closed with a detour, September 16 and September 25.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue closed with a detour between South Lloyd Street and the dead end from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works crews will have mobile operations on the Chuckatuck area, Jackson Road, Manning Road, White Marsh Road, Holy Neck Road, Corinth Chapel Road and Pineview Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Bridge Road) – Beginning Sunday, September 15, 2019, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road between the Chesapeake City line and Harbour View Boulevard overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for milling and paving for approximately 3 weeks.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school busses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately November 2019.

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
