TEEN INJURED IN OVERNIGHT SHOOTING

Suffolk, VA (October 1, 2019) Suffolk Police advise that a male juvenile was injured in an overnight shooting incident that occurred in the Southside Meadows neighborhood.

On September 30, 2019, at approximately 8:22 p.m. Officers responded to the 100 block of Greenfield Crescent for reports of shots fired. Once on scene it was determined that a shooting had taken place and that the juvenile male, age 16, had been dropped off at a local hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time.
