CAR CRASHES INTO STOREFRONT

SUFFOLK, VA (October 17, 2019) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a single vehicle accident involving a passenger vehicle that impacted a Downtown storefront.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 3:18 p.m. advising of the incident at the Shoe Dept. located in the 1100 block of North Main Street.

Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that the adult female driver of the Nissan Sedan jumped the curb and went through the glass front of the building. The driver wasn't injured.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment to two employees, with the male refusing medical transport for minor injuries and a female being ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

A building official from Neighborhood Development Services also responded to determine the extent of the structural damage to the business.

The cause of the accident is under investigation at this time.
