FOUR JUVENILES INJURED IN SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (October 23, 2019) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded to the scene of a single vehicle accident last evening, Tuesday, October 22, 2019, in the 4600 block of Girl Scout Road.

Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at 8:57 p.m. Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that the passenger vehicle occupied by four juveniles left the roadway and struck a tree. Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and a juvenile male was airlifted by Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with serious injuries. A juvenile female was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with serious injuries, and a juvenile male and female were ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital for further medical treatment.

Public Works crews also responded to the scene and the roadway in the rural area was closed from Girl Scout Road between Matoaka Road and Cherokee Road for several hours.

The investigation into the cause of the accident remains ongoing at this time.
