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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 25, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, October 25, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound and westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Holy Neck Road and the Southampton County line for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Hillpoint Boulevard closed with a detour between Birdie Drive and Middlecoff Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound shoulder closure on Route 58 at the Blackwater Bridge for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Tradd Street) – A contractor will have a crew performing test holes on Tradd Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound right shoulder closure on Route 58 over the Nansemond River for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Mineral Spring Road and Arthur Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Mineral Spring Road and Arthur Drive for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works crew will have a mobile operation throughout the Whaleyville area for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Freeney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Freeney Avenue closed between South Division Street and the dead end with a detour for a paving operations from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., October 25, October 28 and October 29.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour for a paving operation from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., October 25, October 28, and October 29.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed with a detour for a paving operation from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., October 25, October 28, and October 29.

Upcoming Projects:

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Beginning, Sunday, October 27, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The milling and paving operation is expected to be completed in 10 days, weather permitting. Message boards will be placed on Monday, October 21 to notify motorists.

Ongoing Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Holland Route/Route 58) -- Norfolk Southern will be conducting extensive repairs to the railroad bridge crossing in the 1300 block of Holland Road/Route 58 (near Ricky & Roy's Catering) beginning on Tuesday, October 22, 2019. The work on and under the bridge will take place on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and the affected portion of the roadway will open after work hours and on the weekend. The noted weekday closures are expected to remain in place through Tuesday, October 29, 2019. Norfolk Southern crews will be placing variable message boards in the area to alert the motoring public to the upcoming closures and detour routing including the use of the Route 58 Bypass, Pitchkettle Road, Constance Road, and Holland Road. The roadway will be open to motorists Friday, October 25, 2019 and will close again Monday, October 28, 2019 at 9 a.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school buses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
