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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 29, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, October 29, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Millwood Way) – A contractor will have Millwood Way closed with a detour between Olde Mill Creek Drive and Mill Run Court for drainage pipe replacement from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., October 28 through October 30.

(Beechwood Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the Beechwood Subdivision for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 460) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile lane closure on Route 460 between Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road for fiber optic installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., October 29 through November 1.

(Route 460) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 460 starting westbound and returning eastbound between the Route 58 interchange and Gardner Lane for asphalt maintenance from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(West Constance Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right turn lane closure on West Constance Road at Western Avenue for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Longstreet Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Shoulders Hill Road between Nansemond Parkway and Bennetts Creek Park for pothole patching from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Townpoint Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Townpoint Road for drainage maintenance from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Route 58 between Kenyon Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for asphalt maintenance. Crews will be working eastbound from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and westbound from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bute Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure in the 100 block of Bute Street from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have southbound stationary left lane closures on Carolina Road between Benton Road and Whaleyville Boulevard from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Godwin Boulevard for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a northbound mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight County line for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations on Shoulders Hill Road between Bob White Lane and Bennetts Creek Park Road from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Beginning, Sunday, October 27, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The milling and paving operation is expected to be completed in 10 days, weather permitting. Message boards were placed on Monday, October 21 to notify motorists.

(Holland Route/Route 58) -- Norfolk Southern will be conducting extensive repairs to the railroad bridge crossing in the 1300 block of Holland Road/Route 58 (near Ricky & Roy's Catering) beginning on Tuesday, October 22, 2019. The work on and under the bridge will take place on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and the affected portion of the roadway will open after work hours and on the weekend. The noted weekday closures are expected to remain in place through Tuesday, October 29, 2019. Norfolk Southern crews will be placing variable message boards in the area to alert the motoring public to the upcoming closures and detour routing including the use of the Route 58 Bypass, Pitchkettle Road, Constance Road, and Holland Road.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school buses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
