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UPDATE

(Millwood Way) – Millwood Way will remain closed overnight, however, the sidewalks will be open to pedestrians. This work is taking place on Millwood Way with a detour between Olde Mill Creek Drive and Mill Run Court for a drainage pipe replacement.

(Holland Route/Route 58) – The 1300 block of Holland Road/Route 58 (near Ricky and Roy's Catering) is open to traffic and will remain open until 9 a.m., Monday, November 4. The work will resume Monday, November 4 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and again on Tuesday, November 5 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 31, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, October 31, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Holland Road) -- A contractor will be working in the shoulder on Holland Road between Beechwood Drive and English Oak Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Thursday, October 31 and from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., Friday, November 1.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Desert Road, White Marsh Road and Badger Road for bridge maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Indian Trail, Lake Cohoon Road, Lake Meade Drive, Herman Court, Jackson Road and Turlington Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will be performing bridge inspections at the following locations from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.: Kings Fork over Lake Cohoon, Lake Meade over Lake Cohoon and Exeter Driver over Lake Prince.

(Suburban Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Suburban Drive between East Washington Street and Portsmouth Boulevard for maintenance at the railroad crossing from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Beechwood Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the Beechwood Subdivision for drainage and shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Everets Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 6700 block of Everets Road for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Route 10 and the Chesapeake City line returning westbound to the Route 13/32 Bypass for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the Chesapeake City line and Kings Highway continuing onto Kings Highway for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Millwood Way) – A contractor will have Millwood Way closed with a detour between Olde Mill Creek Drive and Mill Run Court for drainage pipe replacement from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., October 28 through November 1. The road will reopen on Thursday, October 31 at 3:30 p.m. for Halloween activities.

(Route 460) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile lane closure on Route 460 between Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road for fiber optic installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., October 29 through November 1.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working in the shoulder on Holland Road between Raleigh Drive and Robin lane from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., October 30 through November 1.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Beginning, Sunday, October 27, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The milling and paving operation is expected to be completed in 10 days, weather permitting. Message boards were placed on Monday, October 21 to notify motorists.

(Holland Route/Route 58) -- Norfolk Southern will be conducting extensive repairs to the railroad bridge crossing in the 1300 block of Holland Road/Route 58 (near Ricky & Roy's Catering) beginning on Tuesday, October 22, 2019. The work on and under the bridge will take place on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and the affected portion of the roadway will open after work hours and on the weekend. The noted weekday closures are expected to remain in place through Friday, November 1, 2019. Norfolk Southern crews will be placing variable message boards in the area to alert the motoring public to the upcoming closures and detour routing including the use of the Route 58 Bypass, Pitchkettle Road, Constance Road, and Holland Road.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a section of Pughsville Road closed with a detour in place between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road beginning on Saturday, September 14, 2019. The road is expected to be closed to through traffic for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, accommodations will be made for residents, emergency vehicles, and school buses only.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
