SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT – BRIDGE ROAD

SUFFOLK, VA (November 3, 2019) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to a two vehicle accident involving a passenger vehicle and a backhoe in the 2200 block of Bridge Road this evening, Sunday, November 3, 2019. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 7:08 p.m.

Following emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel, a total of three patients (two from the passenger vehicle and one from the backhoe) were ground transported to an area hospital. The passenger of the vehicle was noted to have possible life threatening injuries. The other two injured patients have non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was completely shut down for approximately 30 minutes. One lane remains closed at this time and will be closed for an undetermined amount of time.

The accident remains under investigation at this time. No additional information is available for release.
