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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 6, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, November 6, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 3 through November 8.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating southbound lane closures on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and the Godwin Bridge for milling and paving overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., November 3 through November 15.

(Henley Place and West Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working at the intersection of Henley Place and West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure on Holland Road between Forest Glen Drive and English Oak Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., November 5 through November 8.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile right lane closure on Pruden Boulevard between Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 5 through November 8.

(Henley Place) – A contractor will have a crew working within the parking lane southbound on Henley Place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Elwood Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 7400 to 7500 blocks of Elwood Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have turn lane closures on Bridge Road between the Chesapeake City limits and Eclipse Drive from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Beechwood Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the Beechwood Subdivision on drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Airport Road, Turlington Road, Jackson Road, and Old Mill Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound Route 58 at the Holland Bypass for bridge maintenance from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.

(Old Somerton Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure in the 1200 block of Old Somerton Road for water line installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Wilroy Road and Portsmouth Boulevard for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on East Washington Street between the railroad trestle and Portsmouth Boulevard for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 12:30 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard between Nansemond Parkway and Wilroy Road for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road from the 600 block to Whaleyville Boulevard for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The work will continue southbound toward the North Carolina border from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road between Murphys Mill Road and Kings Fork Road from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Millwood Way) – A contractor will have Millwood Way closed with a detour between Olde Mill Creek Drive and Mill Run Court for drainage pipe replacement from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., October 28 through November 8.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Beginning, Sunday, October 27, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The milling and paving operation is expected to be completed in 10 days, weather permitting. Message boards were placed on Monday, October 21 to notify motorists.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
