POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 19, 2019) A super load move, involving the hauling of a manufactured home, could cause delays in traffic, Thursday, November 21, 2019, between 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.

The move will come from North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on the Franklin Bypass to Route 260/258 North to Great Mill Highway, to eastbound Route 460 to Old Mill Road to Old Myrtle Road and will end the trip in the 6400 block of Old Myrtle Road.

The truck and load will measure 14 feet 11 inches tall, 14 feet wide, 105 feet long, and weigh 54,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as a Suffolk Police Department escort.
