ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 19, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 19, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pruden Boulevard between the Route 58 Interchange and the Isle of Wight County line for debris removal from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Southampton County line for debris removal from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation throughout the Whaleyville area for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure on Pruden Boulevard at Old Myrtle Road from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound lane closure in the 3000 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Wedgewood Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Wedgewood Drive at Greenway Road from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have flagging operations on Nansemond Parkway between Sportsman Boulevard and Sleepy Hole Road from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Repass Beach Road) – A contractor will have a northbound lane closure on Repass Beach Road between Hampton Roads Parkway and the 6700 block for curb work from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 19 through November 22.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Forest Glen Drive and Cove Point Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., November 19 through November 22.

(Bridge Road and Eclipse Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Signals Crew will have alternating lane closures at the intersection of Bridge Road and Eclipse Drive from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have turn lane closures on Carolina Road between Turlington Road and Airport Road from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Old East Pinner Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 600 block of Old East Pinner Street for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between OKelly Drive and the Southampton County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 189) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Freeney Avenue and Hollywood Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage maintenance on Freeney Avenue and in the Hollywood Subdivision from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure requiring eastbound traffic to shift to the inside lane on Pruden Boulevard at Old Myrtle Road, November 21 and November 22. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists of the upcoming change in traffic pattern.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure in the 3000 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., November 20.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 6600 to 6700 block of Everets Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 20 through November 22.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3700 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 23 and November 24.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures eastbound on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and Holy Neck Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 12 through November 22. Work will be daily including weekends.

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the intersection on both Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 12 through November 26.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
