POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE LOCATING WOMAN WANTED FOR PASSING COUNTERFEIT CURRENCY

SUFFOLK, VA (December 2, 2019) - The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating an adult female wanted for allegedly passing counterfeit currency to purchase prepaid Visa Gift Cards.

The subject is identified as Natesha Lashay Cheeks, age 24, of Suffolk. She is further described as approximately 5'02", 150 pounds, with brown eyes.

The incidents in question occurred on November 13, 2019, at the Rite Aid in the 1500 block of Holland Road, and on November 25, 2019, at the Family Dollar in the 800 block of East Washington Street. In each incident, the subject allegedly passed \$400.00 in counterfeit currency to purchase Visa Gift Cards.
