## **UPDATE**

(Bridgeway Drive) – A contractor will have a turn lane closure on Bridgeway Drive at Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will be working on the shoulder of eastbound Holland Road between Beechwood Drive and English Oak Drive from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.

### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (December 10, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, December 10, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Moore Farm Lane) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 700 block of Moore Farm Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Deer Path Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Deer Path Road for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(North Capital Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North Capital Drive closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Dill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Dill Road between Charlotte Street and Hunter Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a westbound lane closure in the 1200 block of Holland Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m., December 10 and December 11.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a crew working off the shoulder on Holland Road at Kenyon Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will be working at the intersection of Holland Road at Kenyon Road and Forest Glen Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be a temporary shutdown of the travel lanes. During this time, Suffolk Police will be providing traffic control.

(Milford Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Milford Lane for asphalt maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 between Portsmouth Boulevard and the Chesapeake City line for debris pickup from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on the shoulder of South Quay Road at the bridge for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the intersection on both Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 12 through December 22.

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Arthur Drive between Boonetown Road and Spivey Run Road for pavement milling from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., December 4 through December 10.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a crew working in the 5400 block of Shoulders Hill Road in the shoulder from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., December 2 through December 13.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Copeland Road and Liberty Spring Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., December 2 through December 13.

(Pruden Boulevard/Route 460) – Beginning 8 a.m., Thursday, November 21, 2019, a contractor will have a permanent westbound lane closure in the 5000 block of Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 at Old Myrtle Road. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction with the middle lane as a turn lane to Old Myrtle Road and the construction site. The new traffic pattern will be in place for approximately 4 to 6 weeks. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists of the change in traffic pattern. Additionally, the speed limit within the work zone area will be lowered to 45 miles per hour beginning on Thursday, November 21st until the end of the project. Any future changes in traffic patterns will be updated as needed.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
