SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE FOR INFORMATION ON WHEREABOUTS OF MISSING WOMAN

SUFFOLK, VA (January 30, 2020) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance for information on the whereabouts of a woman that her family says has been missing since last February when her disappearance was initially reported.

Chatani B. Wilson, age 23, of Suffolk, was last seen by her family on February 12, 2019, and it is believed that she may be in the City of Virginia Beach. There is no indication at this time that Chatani is in any danger, however, no contact has been made with her family or her child since that date.

Chatani is further described at 5'4" tall and weighs 120 pounds. She has brown hair and brown eyes and is known to wear gray contacts.
