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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (February 6, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, February 6, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane closure on Bridge Road between Walden Road and Shoulders Hill Road and a left turn lane closure on Bridge Road at Shoulders Hill Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will be working off the shoulder eastbound on Holland Road from Forest Glen Drive to Cove Point Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Route 58) – On Friday, February 7th, a contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure on Route 58 at the Nansemond River overpass from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – On Friday, February 7th, a contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Wilroy Road and Woodland Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – On Friday, February 7th, a contractor will have crews on Davenport Court at the Oakridge Substation, Constance Road and Western Avenue from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – On Saturday, February 8th, a contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – On Tuesday, February 11th, a contractor will be performing bridge inspections on Exchange Creek near Girl Scout Road, and Girl Scout Road over Lake Prince, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Lake Meade Drive) – On Thursday, February 13th, a contractor will be performing a bridge inspection on Lake Meade Drive over Lake Cohoon from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Bridge Road) – On Saturday, February 15th, a contractor will have the north and southbound turn lanes and the outside lanes closed on Bridge Road at the intersection of Windward Lane and Bridgeport Way from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to install a traffic signal. The inside lane will remain open to traffic. Traffic will be stopped briefly during the mast arm installation. Suffolk Police Department will be on scene to assist with traffic control.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive.

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., January 13th through February 7th.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16th.

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
