ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (February 25, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, February 25, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Kings Highway and Day Farm Lane from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive between Hampton Roads Parkway and Lake View Parkway from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have short term shoulder closures on Bridge Road between Isle of Wight County and College Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kenyon Court) – A contractor will have a crew working behind the shoulder on Kenyon Court from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., February 24 through February 28.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Route 58 eastbound between Lummis Road and Manning Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Lake Prince Drive between Exeter Drive and Girl Scout Road for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(White Marsh Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1000 block of White Marsh Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., February 24 through February 28.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Signal Crew will have an eastbound mobile operation on Holland Road between Kenyon Road and Grove Avenue from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Airport Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 2000 block of Airport Road for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have an eastbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Lummis Road and the 3200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., February 25 through February 29.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Sleepy Hole Road and Bennetts Pasture Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., February 24 through February 27.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive, February 19 through March 4.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane closure on Bridge Road between Walden Road and Shoulders Hill Road and a left turn lane closure on Bridge Road at Shoulders Hill Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m., February 3 through February 28.

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., January 13 through February 28.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16, 2019.

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
