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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 3, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, March 3, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between the 2600 block and Woodland Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 2 and March 3.

(Dutch Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 800 block of Dutch Road for drainage maintenance from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Jackson Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Jackson Road at Turlington Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be performing a bridge inspection in the 800 block of Carolina Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will be performing a bridge inspection on Bridge Road over Bennett's Creek from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Old Dill Road) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Old Dill Road between Hunter Street and Charlotte Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure on Kings Fork Road between Pruden Boulevard and Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 3 and March 4.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Gardner Lane, Old Myrtle Road, Exeter Drive, and Archers Mill for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will be replacing sections of sidewalk in the 100 block of West Washington Street on Sunday, March 1st through Tuesday, March 3rd. During this time, no parking will be permitted on the westbound side of the street between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. This will allow the crews and equipment to access the area.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 4 through March 6.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive, February 19 through March 4.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a westbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Lummis Road and the 3200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 2 through March 6.

(Kenyon Court) – A contractor will have a crew working behind the shoulder on Kenyon Court from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., February 24 through March 6.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane closure on Bridge Road between Walden Road and Shoulders Hill Road and a left turn lane closure on Bridge Road at Shoulders Hill Road overnight from 7 p.m. to 4 a.m., February 3 through March 5.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at William Reid Drive and alternating lane closures on William Reid Drive overnight from 4 p.m. to 5 a.m., March 2 through March 6.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will be working on and off the shoulder eastbound on Holland Road from Manning Bridge Road to Barrett Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., March 3 through March 6.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
