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## **UPDATE**

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Wilroy Road at the bridge for guardrail repairs from 11:30 am. to 3:30 p.m.

### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 9, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, March 9, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at William Reid Drive and alternating lane closures on William Reid Drive overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., March 9 and March 10.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between the 2600 block and Bennetts Pasture Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m., March 8 and March 9.

(Airport Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Airport Road between Skeetertown Road and Copeland Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between Airport Road and Cypress Chapel Road for asphalt maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Deer Forest Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Deer Forest Road between Carolina Road and Adams Swamp Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Ruritan Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Ruritan Boulevard between Barnes Road and Glen Haven Drive for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Crittenden Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 8300 block of Crittenden Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Driver Lane and Bennetts Pasture Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation at the intersection of Driver Lane and Bennetts Pasture Road for drainage maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(South 6<sup>th</sup> Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on South 6<sup>th</sup> Street between East Washington Street and the bridge from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 at the Blackwater River Bridge for bridge maintenance from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Railroad Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Railroad Street closed with a detour between North Lloyd Street and North Capital Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have mobile shoulder closures on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Road from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a flagging operation on East Washington Street between County Street and White Marsh Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road at Shoulders Hill Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 9 and March 10.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6100 block of Godwin Boulevard for guardrail repair from 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

### **Upcoming Projects:**

(William Reid Drive) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on William Reid Drive overnight from 4:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Wednesday, March 11 and Thursday, March 12.

### **Ongoing Projects:**

(Nansemond Parkway) – Beginning March 4, a contractor will have a permanent outside eastbound lane closure in the 5400 block of Nansemond Parkway for curb and

entrance improvements. Work is expected to be complete by March 18, weather permitting.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a westbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Lummis Road and the 3200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 2 through March 14.

(Kenyon Court) – A contractor will have a crew working behind the shoulder on Kenyon Court from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., February 24 through March 13.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
