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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 18, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, March 18, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will be working off the shoulder on Holland Road between Kenyon Road and Raleigh Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will be working off the shoulder on Kenyon Road at Holland Road from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Signals Crew will have a southbound left lane closure on Bridge Road at Bennetts Pasture Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working off the shoulder in the 5000 block of Pruden Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on the bridges on: Girl Scout Road, Kings Fork Road, Old Myrtle Road and Lake Cahoon Road for herbicide application from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Adams Swamp Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Adams Swamp Road for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Simons Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Simons Drive for asphalt maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Pruden Boulevard between North Main Street and the Isle of Wight County line for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have southbound right lane closures at the following locations on Bridge Road for guardrail repairs: 1800-1900 block from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m., Route 164 Interchange from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 3400 Bridge Road from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Skeetertown Road) – A contractor will have Skeetertown Road closed with a detour from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through April 24.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a left northbound right lane closure on Bridge Road at the Godwin Bridge on from 7 p.m. to 4 a.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a left southbound lane closure in the 3800 block of Bridge Road from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., March 21.

Ongoing Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – Beginning March 4, a contractor will have a permanent outside eastbound lane closure in the 5400 block of Nansemond Parkway for curb and entrance improvements. Work is expected to be complete by March 20, weather permitting.

(Turlington Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road at Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 11 through March 20.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Cherry Blossom Drive and Regency Drive for a storm water pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 11 through March 25.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound outside lane closure and lane shift on Route 58 between Grove Avenue and Faulk Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., March 16 through March 20.

(Route 58) – A contractor will be working off the shoulder on Holland Road between Kenyon Road and Raleigh Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., March 17 through March 20. No traffic control needed.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will be working off the shoulder on Kenyon Road at Holland Road from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. March 17 through March 20. No traffic control needed.

(various locations) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations on Burbage Landing Circle, Chambers Lane, Meekins Way, Worcester Lane, Glenrose Drive and Respass Beach Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 16 through April 3. Dates and locations will vary during this time.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through May 1.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3900 to 4100 blocks of Pughsville Road for a paving operation from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., March 16 through March 19.

(South 6th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on South 6th Street between East Washington Street and the bridge from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a permanent outside eastbound lane closure in the 5400 block of Nansemond Parkway for curb and entrance improvements. Work is expected to be complete March 20th, weather permitting.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a westbound shoulder closure for approximately 1 hour then switching to an eastbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Lummis Road and the 3200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 2 through March 20.

(Kenyon Court) – A contractor will have a crew working behind the shoulder on Kenyon Court from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., February 24 through March 27.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
