**POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IDENTIFYING WOMAN WANTED  
FOR PASSING COUNTERFEIT MONEY AND OBTAINING MONEY BY FALSE  
PRETENSE**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 26, 2020) The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying a woman that is wanted for passing counterfeit money and obtaining money by false pretense. The incidents in question occurred on February 19, 2020, at several businesses in Suffolk, including Cypress Saddlery, two local ABC Stores, Subway, Dollar Tree, and Pizza Hut. The subject is described as a black female, 5'4"- 5'5", approximately 180 pounds, a nose ring on the left side, with well-manicured nails and is possibly pregnant as she rubs her stomach expectantly in surveillance video footage.

Anyone that is able to identify the woman or with any information is asked to contact Suffolk Police or Suffolk Crime Line.
