ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (April 17, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, April 17, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 7000 block of Whaleyville Boulevard for debris pick up and tree removal from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a crew on Pitchkettle Road over Lake Meade for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between the Holland Road interchange and Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bennetts Pasture Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bennetts Pasture Road at Lee Farm Lane from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1700 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a northbound lane closure in the 6300 block of Whaleyville Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have the 100 block of Charlotte Avenue closed with a detour for an emergency service installation from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Longstreet Lane, Rountree Crescent, and Freeman Mill for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Kennedy Subdivision) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the Lake Kennedy Subdivision for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound returning westbound mobile left lane closure on Route 58 between the Holland Road interchange and the Chesapeake city line for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed with a detour between North Division Street and North Lloyd Street from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have crews working beyond the shoulder on Route 58 between Manning Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., April 16 through April 24. Work will take place Tuesday through Friday.

(Holland Road and Kenyon Road/Forest Glen Drive) – A contractor will be working off the road at the intersection of Holland Road and Kenyon Road/Forest Glen Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., April 15 through April 17.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Pitchkettle Road at Craig Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., April 16 and April 17.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on West Washington Street between Pine Street and Clay Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 14 to April 17.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., April 14 through April 17.

Upcoming Projects:

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have Sleepy Hole Road closed with a detour between River Breeze Road and Kings Highway to install utility connections beginning April 20. This closure is anticipated to last approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1400 block of Bridge Road, at the bridge, overnight from 7 p.m. to 4 a.m., April 23.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between the Holland Road Interchange and the Southampton County line for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 18.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Kings Highway between Crittenden Road and Bob House Parkway overnight from 4 p.m. to 7 a.m., April 21.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will have a left turn lane closure on Kenyon Road at Holland from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 21.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure on Route 58 from the Route 189 interchange toward Southampton County for milling and paving from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., April 6 through April 17.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through April 24.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through May 1.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Cherry Blossom Drive and Regency Drive for a storm water pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 11 through April 21.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
