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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (April 30, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, April 30, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard for vegetation maintenance and litter control from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – HRSD will have a mobile shoulder closure on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Old College Drive then continuing down Old College Drive to Hampton Roads Parkway from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile alternating lane closures westbound on Route 58 between Holy Neck Road and the Southampton County line from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will be working off the road in the 1500 block of Holland Road from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Turlington Road/Jackson Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Turlington Road and Jackson Road for paving from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

(South 6th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of South 6th Street from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a northbound mobile operation in the 900 block of Carolina Road for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a southbound mobile operation in the 6100 block of Whaleyville Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the Whaleyville area for asphalt maintenance from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **Upcoming Projects:**

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have a crew working within the shoulder on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road and Lummis Road from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

### **Ongoing Projects:**

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have Sleepy Hole Road closed to through traffic between River Breeze Road and Kings Highway to install utility connections beginning April 20. This closure is anticipated to last approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting. Residents do have access to their neighborhood at River Breeze Road.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020.

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
