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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 4, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, May 4, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a crew working within the shoulder on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road and Lummis Road from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 4 through May 8.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Road from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a crew working beyond the shoulder on Route 58 between Grove Avenue and Kenyon Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 4 through May 8.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a crew working within the shoulder on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road and Lummis Road from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 4 through May 8.

(Jackson Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 2600 block of Jackson Road from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Elwood Road and Freeman Mill Road) – A contractor will be performing bridge inspections on Elwood Road over Kingsale Swamp and Freeman Mill Road over Spivey Swamp from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the 3300 block and East Washington Street for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on East Washington Street between Portsmouth Boulevard and the railroad underpass for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Carolina Road and the North Carolina state line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a flagging operation on Lake Prince Drive between Lake Point Road and Starcher Court from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures westbound on Route 58 between Holy Neck Road and the Southampton County line from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have two locations on Bank Street Extended closed with a detour, May 4 through May 8. The locations will be between North Lloyd Street and North Division Street and between North Capital Street and North 4th Street from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Bridge Road, Pruden Boulevard and Portsmouth Boulevard for herbicide application from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Townpoint Road and Driver Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Townpoint Road and Driver Lane for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Leafwood Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Leafwood Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation northbound and southbound on the Route 13/32 Bypass for herbicide application from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Great Fork Road, Greenway Road, Deer Forest Road, Buckhorn Drive, Indian Trail, Deer Path Road, Bennetts Pasture Road and Sleepy Hole Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have Sleepy Hole Road closed to through traffic between River Breeze Road and Kings Highway to install utility connections beginning April 20. This closure is anticipated to last approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting. Residents do have access to their neighborhood at River Breeze Road.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 30 through May 22.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately June 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
