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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 14, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, May 14, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working beyond the shoulder on Route 58/Holland Road between Manning Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., May 13 through May 15.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile shoulder closure on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and College Drive then continue to Old College Drive to Hampton Roads Parkway from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the Chesapeake City Line and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Collins Road, Dutch Road, Lake Meade Drive, and Lake Cahoon Road for debris pickup and vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 300 block of Kings Highway from 3 p.m. to 10 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed with a detour between North Division Street and North Lloyd Street from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Shoulders Hill Road at Dutchess Way to remove debris from the roadway from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Sweatt Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Sweatt Road for asphalt repair from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Holland Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation., May 11 through May 22.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Bright Lane and Withers Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 8 through May 15.

(South 6th Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on South 6th Street at Truman Road for a milling operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 12 through May 14.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6700 block of Everets Road from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., May 12 through May 15.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 30 through May 22.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately June 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
