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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 20, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, May 20, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(South 6th Street / Truman Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on South 6th Street and Truman Road for a milling and paving operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Wilroy Road between Executive Drive and QVC Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6600 and 6700 block of Everets Road for a drainage pipe installation from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended between North Capital and North 4th Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Holland Road /Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Holland Road/ Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Holland Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering crew will have a westbound right shoulder closure on Route 58 between Pitchkettle Road and the Route 13/32 (Southern) Bypass exit ramp for sign maintenance from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 interchange and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering crew will have a southbound right lane closure on Bridge Road at Breezeport Way for traffic signal maintenance from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Holland Road /Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound right lane closure in the 6300 block of Holland Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Kilby Road between Lake Cahoon Road and Pitchkettle Road for drainage maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Walter Earl Lane) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Walter Earl Lane at Green Spring Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Longstreet Lane, Townpoint Road, and Girl Scout Road for debris removal and vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a mobile flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Townpoint Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 26.

Ongoing Projects:

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation., May 11 through May 22.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6700 block of Everets Road from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., May 12 through May 22.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 30 through May 22.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately June 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
