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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 21, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, May 21, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(South 6th Street / Truman Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on South 6th Street and Truman Road for a milling and paving operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Wilroy Road between Executive Drive and QVC Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. On Friday, May 22, hours of work will be 7 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Everets Road) – A contractor have a flagging operation in the 6600 and 6700 block of Everets Road for a drainage pipe installation from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Bank Street Extended at North 4th Street for drainage upgrades from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Holland Road /Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Holland Road/ Route 58 between the Holland Bypass and Route 189 for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.

(Ruritan Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Ruritan Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Godwin Boulevard between Kings Highway and the Isle of Wight county line for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Armstead Road for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and College Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Great Fork Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 700 block of Great Fork Road from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will be working on the shoulder in the 2600 block of East Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Kilby Shores Drive) – A contractor will have the two inside lanes closed on Kilby Shores Drive at Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Kilby Road between Lake Cohoon Road and Pitchkettle Road for drainage maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Cohoon Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 2000 block of Lake Cohoon Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Various) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Drum Hill Road, Collins Road, Copeland Road, Airport Road, Kings Highway, and Sleepy Hole Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a mobile flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Townpoint Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 26.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Bright Lane and Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 27 through June 5.

Ongoing Projects:

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation., May 11 through May 22.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6700 block of Everets Road from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., May 12 through May 22. On Friday, May 22, hours of work will be 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 30 through May 22. On Friday, May 22, hours of work will be 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately June 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
