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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 22, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, June 22, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Bob White Lane, OKelly Drive, Southwestern Boulevard, Trumpet Drive, Horton Drive and Dutch Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Deer Path Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 3000 block of Deer Path Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Downtown Holland Bypass and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended between North Capital Street and North 4<sup>th</sup> Street closed with a detour from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will be mowing the slopes on Route 58 westbound at Pitchkettle Road from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between Centerbrooke Drive and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Townpoint Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 5000 block of Townpoint Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have northbound flagging operations on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babbtown Road and Carolina Road continuing on Carolina Road to Turlington Road for asphalt repair from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bennetts Pasture Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Bennetts Pasture Road between Bridge Road and Harbor Road from 10:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a southbound right lane closure in the 300 block of North Main Street for sidewalk repairs from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound mobile operation in the 2000 block of Portsmouth Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Crittenden Road) – A contractor will be working off the road in the 6000 block of Crittenden Road from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound and westbound inside shoulder closures on Route 58 1 mile east of the Southampton County line from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 22 through June 24

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have a crew working within the closure on Blythewood lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 24.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 30.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 1.

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation from May 11 through June 29.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately July 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
