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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 26, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, June 26, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Crittenden Road) – A contractor will be working on the shoulder in the 6900 block of Crittenden Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed with a detour between North 4th Street and North Capital Street for drainage upgrades for 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between the 800 block and the Whaleyville Boulevard split for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working westbound on the shoulders of Route 58 at the bridges and overpasses between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) -- Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Quaker Drive, Pitchkettle Road, Crittenden Road and surrounding areas and Holy Neck Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Beechwood Avenue) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Beechwood Avenue for paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The start date is to be determined.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have intermittent eastbound right lane closures in the 1500 block of Route 58/Holland Road from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., June 29.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound and westbound inside shoulder closures on Route 58 one mile east of the Southampton County line from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 29.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through July 30.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Kenyon Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 24 through June 26.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 4000 block of Sleepy Hole Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 24 through June 26.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working eastbound on Route 58/Holland Road eastbound beyond the shoulder between Manning Road and Staley Drive from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, June 25 through July 3.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a crew working beyond the shoulder in the 2300 block of Holland Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., June 22 through June 26.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 1.

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation from May 11 through July 20.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately July 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

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
